



THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN  
AND THE  
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF MAURITIUS  
FOR COOPERATION IN THE TOURISM FIELD**

The Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and the Government of the Republic of Mauritius (hereinafter referred to as the contracting parties) desirous to broaden further the friendly relations between their countries on the basis of equality and developing the tourism relations between their countries, have agreed as follow:

**Article 1**

The contracting parties shall take all the necessary measures to promote and to encourage the development of tourism between their two countries, and to facilitate reciprocal tourist movement with cooperation of the travel agencies and other structures and organizations linked with touristic activity.

**Article 2**

The contracting parties shall examine possible ways of facilitating and encourage tourism investments, within the framework of laws and regulations in each of the two countries.

**Article 3**

The contracting parties agree to facilitate the exchange of information and statistics in the two countries on matters concerning tourism in conformity with the domestic laws and regulations of each of the two countries, and encouraging both parties to participate in tourism exhibitions and to cooperate and coordinate by both countries in international events and organizations.

**Article 4**

The contracting parties shall encourage the movement to the touristic sites in both countries.

### **Article 5**

The contracting parties shall explore the possibilities to develop and strengthen technical cooperation, namely in the fields of professional training expertise.

### **Article 6**

The contracting parties shall exchange the experiences and information related to tourism enterprises in accordance with their respective national legislation.

### **Article 7**

The contracting parties will facilitate reciprocal information of the touristic possibilities in the two countries in conformity with the domestic laws and regulations of each of the two countries, encouraging to this effect the interchange of Journalists and other professionals for the furtherance of tourism.

### **Article 8**

The contracting parties shall take necessary measures in mutual securing safety of tourists visiting each others country according to the international standards.

### **Article 9**


The present Agreement will be approved according to the procedures in each of the two countries and shall come into force from the date of signing and will be valid for a period of five years and will be automatically renewed for further periods if neither of the contracting parties denounce it, at least six months prior to its expiry.
